DEAR COLLEAGUES

As our membership increases, we're putting out a call for volunteers to take an active role in our association by occupying interim branch leadership and organizational positions in order to help expand our regional activities and member representation.

In one of our previous communications, we shared with you how MPPAC is organized and accountable to its members under the association's constitution. This democratic structure calls for 16 branches: 14 regional branches, and one branch *each* for National Headquarters and Depot — just like the RCMP itself.

Until our first annual general meeting, where any active member in good standing may run for their branch leadership (among other positions), we're calling for volunteers to step up and assume responsibilities according to this structure on an interim basis.

These leadership and organizational roles are first and foremost about building relationships with your colleagues and fulfilling MPPAC's mandate to improve the lives of all members of the force.
