This communication is to advise you that we, the Mounted Police Professional Association of Canada (MPPAC), are seeking the current status of a Code of Conduct and Statutory Investigation on behalf of one of our members, [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] made us aware that [REDACTED] was named in a complaint by another member, [REDACTED], which precipitated a RCMP Code of Conduct and Statutory Investigation. [REDACTED] provided us with all other details relevant to [REDACTED] situation.

It has also come to our attention that there may have been similar complaints of this nature possibly involving [REDACTED] in the past and that this may not be an isolated incident. From our recent discussions with our member, we anticipate that these processes, and the subsequent final report, will exonerate [REDACTED].

On behalf of our member, [REDACTED], we ask the following:

- A prompt written response, indicating when the final reports will be released; and, ultimately, a copy of the final reports as it pertains to these two processes.

- Implementation of a working schedule in which [REDACTED] will not be assigned any future working shifts with [REDACTED].
- Assurances that the resolution of this matter includes provisions for promptly dealing with any future unfounded allegations of this kind in terms of our member.
- For a formal reply to this request no later than Friday 13 May 2011.

More and more members of the RCMP are coming to recognize our organization as a positive force for change in the future of labour relations and as a truly independent voice for members and their interests.
