**Re: Mounted Police Association of Ontario et al. v. Canada
(Attorney General) et al.
Court File No: 34948**

We are writing to advise that our client, the Mounted Police Members' Legal Fund ("Legal Fund"), has no objection to the sur-reply delivered by the Association des Membres de la Police Montée du Québec ("AMPMQ") on January 4, 2016.

In addition, we are taking this opportunity to request directions respecting sur-reply from our client. In the reply of the Attorney General of Canada ("AGC") to the Legal Fund dated December 23, 2015 (which we did not receive until December 30, 2015), the AGC submits that the Legal Fund is not entitled to make submissions or adduce evidence in response to the AGC's motion under Rules 52 and 76. The AGC asks the Court to "wholly disregard" the Legal Fund's responding motion record. This is obviously of great concern to the Legal Fund since its acceptance would result in the Court not receiving submissions and evidence concerning the impact of the AGC's motion on about 17,000 members of the RCMP (i.e. the vast majority of RCMP members) who are also Legal Fund members.

Since the Rules are silent on the issue of sur-replies to motions under Rules 52 and 76, the Legal Fund respectfully requests directions as to whether it can be permitted to file a brief sur-reply of no more than two (2) pages concerning the Legal Fund's status to participate in the instant motion. If the answer is affirmative, then the Legal Fund will
