What is covered?

Legal Defence

Defends a member from highway traffic prosecutions.

Hearing Appeals

If a member disagrees with a decision made regarding their employment or a conduct board hearing, the member will be provided with legal representation to appeal the matter.

Police Conduct Investigations

A member will be provided with legal representation if the member is required to appear or to give evidence during an investigation into alleged criminal conduct by a police officer.

Coroner's Inquests

A member will be provided with legal representation if the member is required to appear or to give evidence during a coroner's inquest.

Tax Protection

Pays for a member's legal costs in respect of a personal tax audit or the appeal of such an audit.

24/7 Telephone Legal Advice

Members have access to a legal advice helpline.

Enhanced assistance

Members have access up to two hours of enhanced legal support for a single matter.

Coverage Limits

\$25,000 per claim, maximum

\$25,000 per policy period

The following three conditions must be met in order for an Insured Event to be covered by the MPPAC Legal Assistance Program:

- The Date of Occurrence of the Insured Event must be during the policy period,
- The officer must be a member of MPPAC prior to the Date of Occurrence, and
- The member must be employed as an officer of the RCMP and must be carrying out their duties for the RCMP.
