The following message is sent on behalf of MPPAC (after recent discussions with the NPF). The AMPMQ has recently launched a new website ([savemyRCMP.ca](http://savemyRCMP.ca)) which is purported to have been created to force a council between all three associations.

While we agree with AMPMQ's views that RCMP Members are in dire need of representation, their most recent attempt through the [savemyRCMP.ca](http://savemyRCMP.ca) website is ill advised and can only lead to further delays in the certification process.

By signing the "Council's" card, MPPAC and NPF members are relinquishing their respective associations' rights to go through the certification process on their behalf. AMPMQ's actions will only serve to undermine the certification process further and lead the PSLREB to *question* the membership status of members who have signed its new card.

Therefore, we strongly encourage our members to refuse to sign the AMPMQ's card and carry on the fight in order to certify a bargaining agent in the near future.
