I am writing in response to your correspondence concerning the deaths of four Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) officers in Mayerthorpe, Alberta, in 2005.

The events which occurred in Mayerthorpe were thoroughly reviewed. This included a fatality inquiry led by Justice Pahl, an Independent Officer Review as well as a Hazardous Occurrence Investigation Report conducted by a team of RCMP employees, including a Staff Relations Representative. Furthermore, a Hazardous Occurrence Investigation Report was also conducted by Human Resources and Skills Development Canada.

All of the recommendations made as a result of these reviews were implemented by the RCMP.
